

THE SWEARING-IN CEREMONY OF THE MEMBERS OF THE THIRD COUNTY ASSEMBLY.

The twenty elected and thirteen nominated members of the County Assembly took the Oath of the office on Wednesday, 21st September 2022. As highlighted under Article 74 of the Constitution of Kenya 2010, no person shall assume or perform any functions of the office of a member before taking and subscribing to the oath of office provided for under paragraph (3).

The ceremony commenced at 9:00 am as the clerk began by reading the notification of the convening of the County Assembly as published in the gazette and then laid a list of the thirty three names of the elected and nominated members on the table of the Assembly.

The clerk, Mr. Chare Mato, then administered the oath of the office provided in the First Schedule of the County Governments Act to all the members present. The oath was administered in an alphabetical order but the members with the longest serving years were given precedence. While taking the oath, the members used either Kiswahili or English. Taking their religions into consideration, the Muslims held the Quran while the Christian members held the Bible while taking their oath.
