**\*7\*QUESTION**

Hon.Speaker, the use of public funds should be prudent and accountability is required from the officers concerned. We are all aware that public funds was used during the assumption of office of the Governor after the successful election of 9<sup>th</sup> August, 2022 general election.

Cognizant to the fact that the Assumption of the office of Governor Act 2019 has given guidelines on how the process of the Assumption of office of the Governor should be carried out. Pursuant to Section 5 (10) of the Assumption of the office of Governor States-; *“The term of office of a committee established under this Section shall lapse upon the submission of the report of the Committee to the County Assembly in accordance with Section 18”*

Upon this, there was public funds that was used during the Assumption of the office of Governor and Pursuant to Section 18 of Assumption of the Office of the Governor Act, 2019, states-;

1. *The committee shall, within a period of one month from the date of swearing of the County Governor-elect, cause to be prepared a report on the affairs of the committee.*
2. *The Committee shall submit to the respective County Assembly the report prepared under sub-section (1)*

3. *The report shall contain, in respect of the Assumption of office by the County Governor elect under this Act.*

I wish to request for a report on the Assumption of the office of Governor from the committee charged with the responsibility under the Assumption of the office of Governor and much emphasis should be given to the following-;

- (a) The Financial statements of the Committee;
- (b) A description of activities of the Committee;
- (c) Such other statistical information as the committee considers appropriate relating to its mandate; and
- (d) Any other information relating to its functions that the committee considers necessary.
