***8* MOTION: STATE OF HEALTH SERVICES IN MARSABIT COUNTY**

AWARE THAT Article 43 of the Kenyan Constitution guarantees every citizen the right to the highest attainable standard of health, including access to health care services.

FURTHER AWARE THAT health is a devolved function under the Fourth Schedule of the Constitution, thereby placing responsibility for the provision of quality and accessible health services on county governments;

NOTING THAT health service delivery in Marsabit County continues to face serious challenges, including ever-growing shortages of essential medicines; acute shortages of pharmaceutical and non-pharmaceutical supplies; inadequate numbers of health workers, including doctors, nurses, and other critical staff; delays in payment of staff salaries, leading to demotivation and low morale; and dilapidated health infrastructure, including hospitals, health centres, and dispensaries, that are ill-equipped to meet the health needs of our growing population;

COGNIZANT THAT these challenges have negatively affected access to quality health care, endangered the lives of many residents, and undermined the confidence of our people in the county's health system;

NOW THEREFORE, the County Assembly resolves that the County Executive Committee Member (CECM) for Health, in collaboration with the CECM for Finance and Economic Planning,
